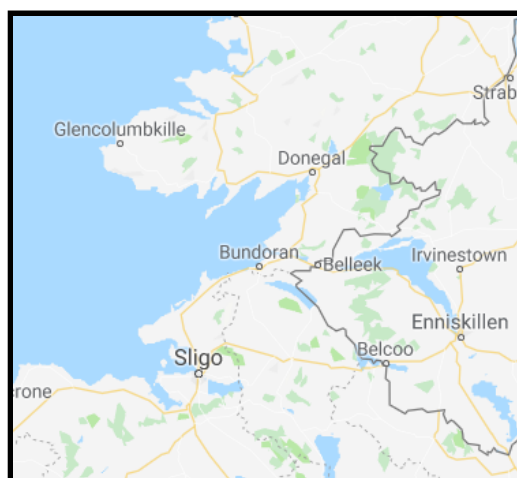

## Exodus North West – Sligo & Donegal Regional Worker

Exodus has been ministering in the North West of Ireland since 2014; **standing beside churches and organisations in calling young people to boldly follow Jesus.** With a warmth of support from local churches we are now **seeking to appoint a full time regional worker.** This person will minister alongside the Exodus NW family, led by Regional Director, Andy Lamberton, in igniting and serving disciple making youth ministry across the Sligo and South Donegal area.



The role will include developing partnerships with local churches and the oversight of ministry opportunities including: **regular events, mentoring, teams, schools work, residentials and training.**

It will require someone with **experience of youth ministry**, a passion to see young people **personally encounter Jesus** and the **leadership ability** to pioneer and partner as we seek to **stand alongside churches in youth ministry.**
