- Consistent invitational opportunities including drop-ins and seasonal events.

DISCIPLE: Local young people are invested in as followers and disciple makers through:

- A wide range of **local Exodus teams**.
- A vibrant and growing DISCIPLES group
- **Directly leading** an Exodus team, mentoring young people and recruiting leaders each year.

PARTNER: Local churches and schools are supported and encouraged through:

- Ministry and programmes together
- Clear invitation & opportunities to support our local work.

BUILD - Our foundations for existing & future work are strong and sustainable through:

- Raising funds for Exodus North East, through occasional events and challenges.
- Growing awareness and prayer support through our weekly prayer time,
 Whatsapp Community and wider communication.
- Ensuring the buildings and facilities continue to deliver a first class experience.
